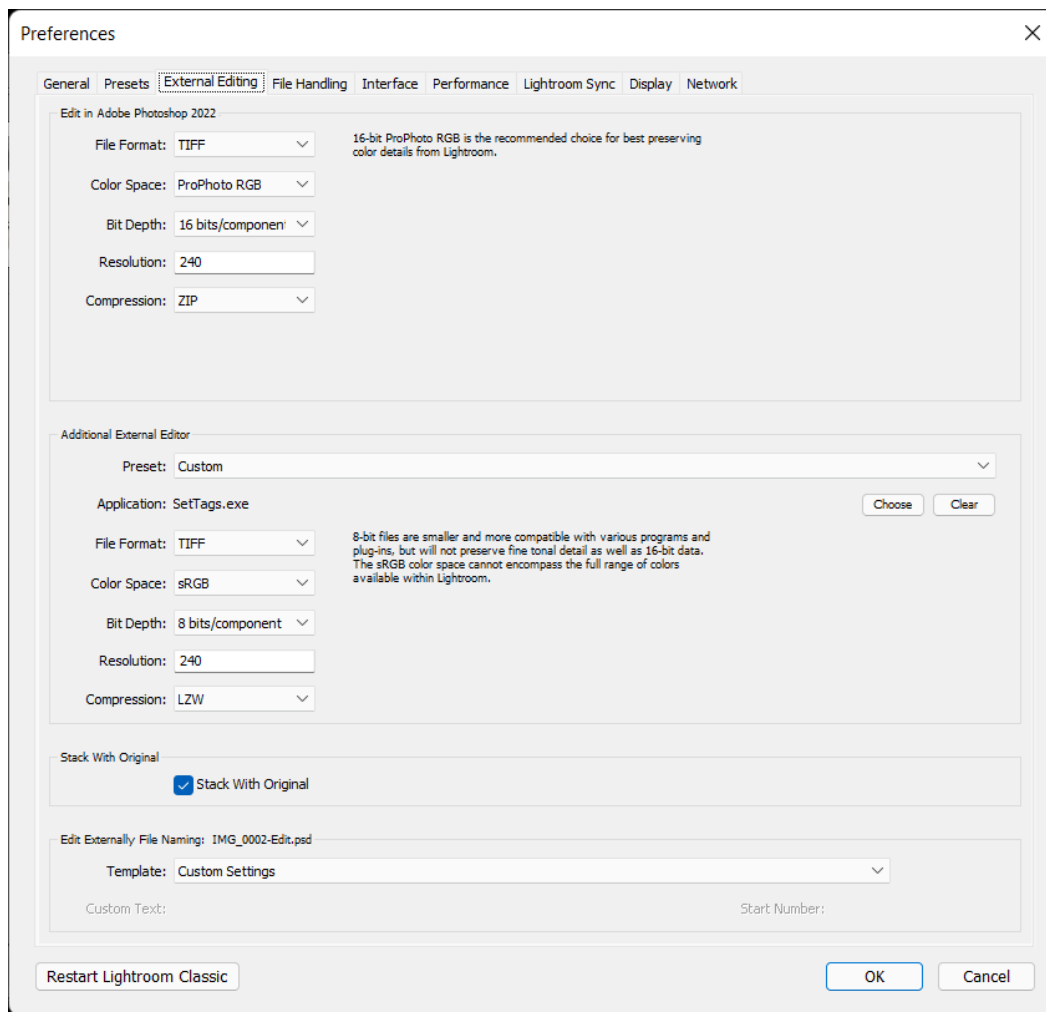
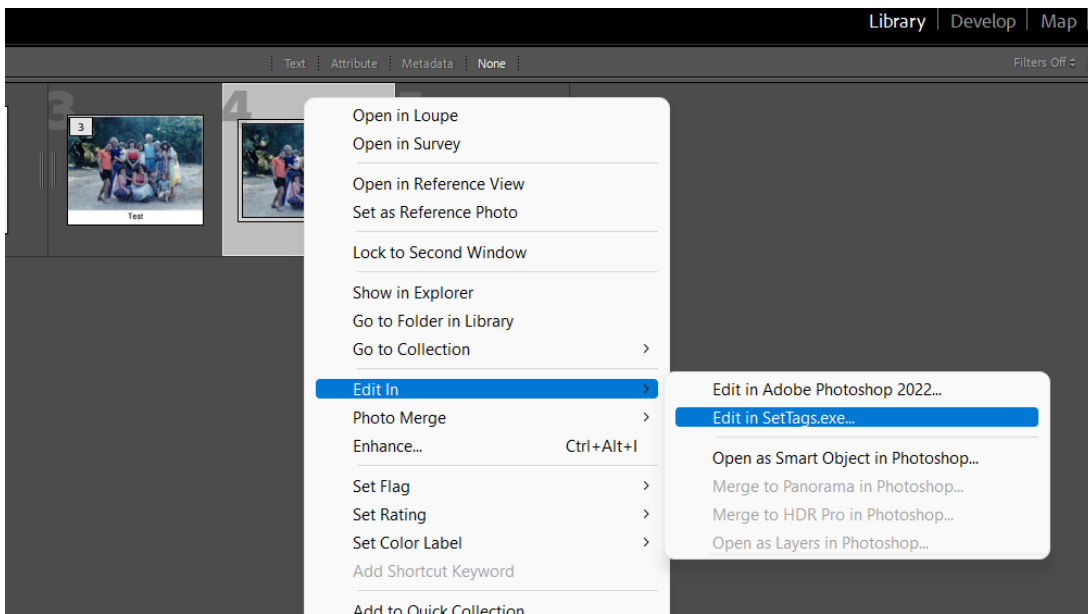
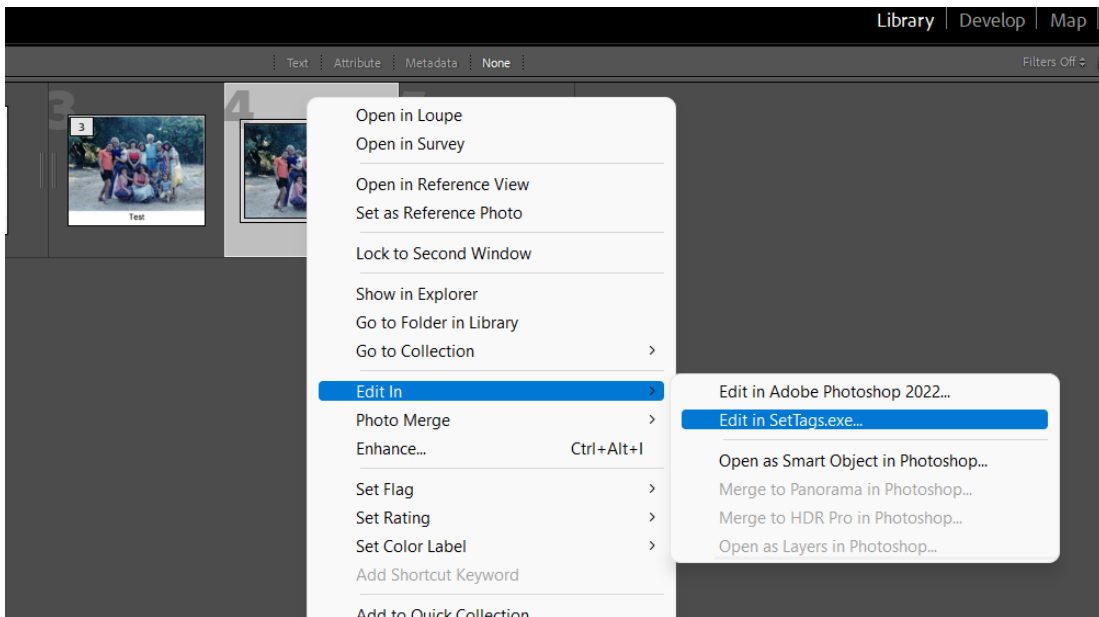


Using Caption Pro as an External Editor with Adobe Lightroom Classic

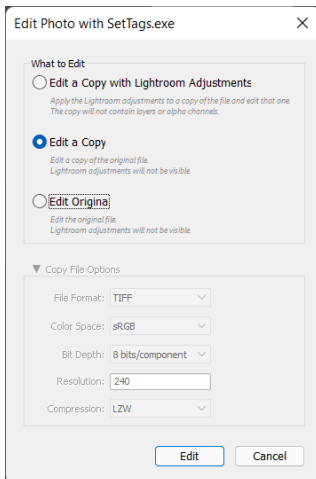
Adobe Lightroom is widely used for editing and managing photos. The Classic version includes the ability to specify external applications which can be used for editing functionality not available in Adobe Photoshop. External applications can be specified via the External Editing tab of the Edit->Preferences menu option which appears as below:



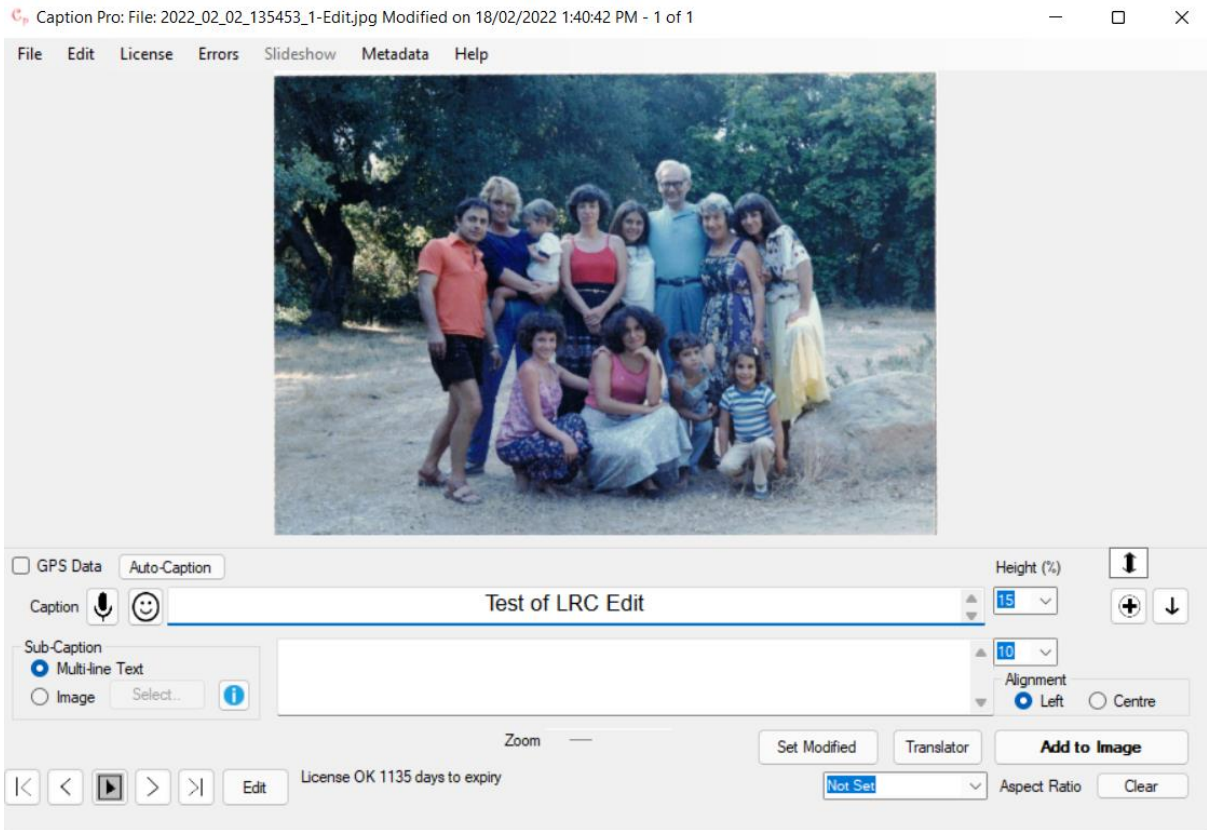
Click the Choose button in the Additional External Editor panel, and select the SetTags.exe file in the folder C:\Program Files\Aleka Consulting\Caption Pro. Then right-click on the selected photo in Lightroom and select Edit In->Edit in SetTags.exe as shown below:



Select Edit Original to change the loaded photo or Edit Copy to create a new captioned file.



Caption Pro then appears with the selected photo loaded:



Ensure that Caption Pro Options include overwriting the original file, click Add to Image and close Caption Pro. If Edit Original is selected, the selected file is replaced by the captioned one:
